Practical Love: 6. Stepping Out – Mark 14.32-42

Jesus was willing to step out of his comfort zone for us. Will we do so for him?

- 1. Be <u>emotionally</u> vulnerable, because it demonstrates <u>authenticity</u>.
- 2. Be <u>physically</u> vulnerable, because <u>suffering</u> is part of the Christian life.

<u>LifeConnect Group Discussion Questions</u>

- Do you have a favourite place to go when you are trying to deal with difficult situations? Where is that? Why do you go there?
- Why did Jesus take Peter, James and John with him to pray?
- Why don't the disciples share Jesus' sense of urgency? (Read chapter 13 to learn why it seems odd that they wouldn't.)
- Why did the woman (14.3) know to prepare Jesus for his burial when the disciples did not?
- Why did Jesus urge Peter specifically to "watch and pray" (v. 34)?
- How do you feel, knowing that Jesus acknowledged his own angst over his crucifixion? Read the Psalms to learn more about this kind of vulnerability.
- Jesus suffered more than we could imagine for us. Is there a limit to the suffering you would endure for the cause of his name?
